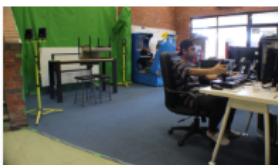
Assessment Item 3 – Produce digital content (explained below)

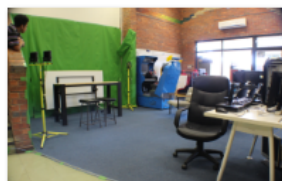

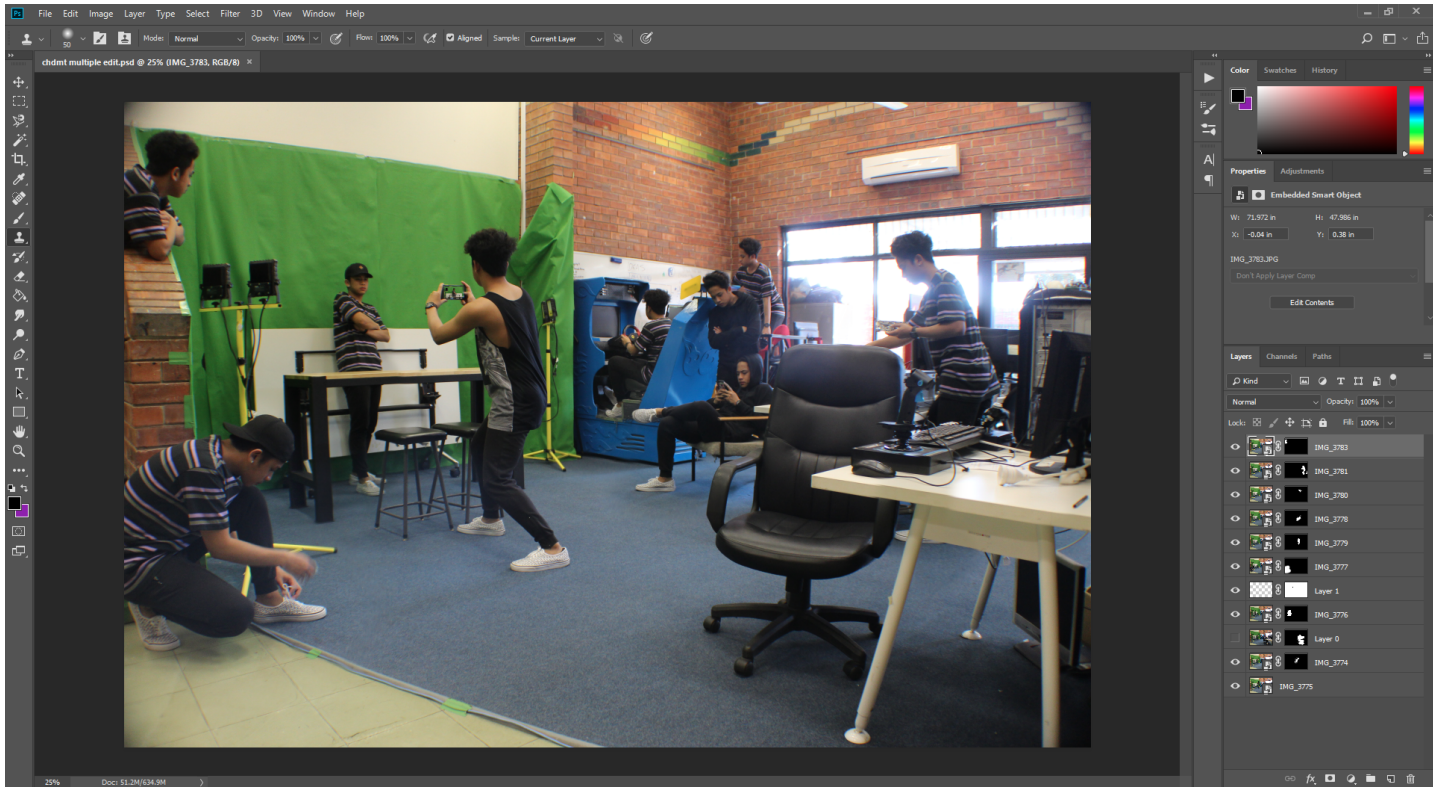
